Dear Valued Customer:

This letter is in reference to your request for Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) on the following product(s):

## Callergy Clear Lotion (Caladryl)

We are not required to hold MSDS information on these items. The reason for this is as follows: Ethical, over-the-counter and cosmetic products in final dosage forms that are supplied for patient care are not subject to hazardous materials standards, since they do not pose a danger to those handling the products in the forms in which they are supplies. Therefore, these products are exempt from MSDS Requirements under OSHA Hazard Communication Standards 1910.1200(b)(5) and (vii), which provide the following exemptions:

- 1. Products which are in "solid," final form for direct administration to the patient,
- 2. Foods, drugs and cosmetics which are packaged for retail sale to the customer.

Our Pharmaceutical drug products are prescribed, stored, prepared, dispensed and administered according to the directions in the product labeling and packaging and they are regulated by the Food and Drug Administration.
